



Invest in yourself, your family, and your community by applying for the Westside Leadership Institute (WLI), a community leadership course! The 12-week program offers leadership development skills and resources. WLI is accepting applications from individuals who are willing to work with a team (either by signing up with a team or working with an assigned team in class) and plan to work on a community project or issue affecting Salt Lake City's Westside. Topics can include but are not limited to: school involvement, neighborhood improvement, community councils, or cultural groups.

- WLI is a leadership training program that covers basic leadership principles, such as building collaborations, leading meetings, and transforming ideas into action.
- The WLI Fall 2017 session will be taught each Tuesday from 6 pm – 9 pm from September 5 to December 5 at NeighborWorks Salt Lake.
- WLI is taught by University of Utah professors and community leaders and is in partnership with University Neighborhood Partners, NeighborWorks Salt Lake, and the University of Utah.
- After completing the WLI course, teams will be eligible to apply for a matching grant of up to \$1,000 for their projects or \$500 for individual projects.
- The cost is \$50/student and due on the first day of class. We can arrange payment plans if necessary. Check, cash, or credit card are accepted.
