



Wolf & Meritus Scholarships Application 2018-2019 Academic Year

University Neighborhood Partners (UNP) offers annual scholarships to increase access to higher education for Salt Lake City west side students. The mission of UNP is to bring together University of Utah and west side resources in reciprocal learning, action, and benefit... *a community coming together.*

Up to five (5) \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded for the upcoming 2018-19 academic year:

- 1 Harold H. & Joan S. Wolf Scholarship; and
- 4 Meritus Scholarships

Each scholarship may be utilized for education expenses resulting from a post-secondary program, including vocational and technical trainings. (I.e. tuition, books, fees, and/or supplies).

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for a Wolf or Meritus Scholarship, you must be one of the following:

- A high school senior;
- Someone who has earned a GED;
- A freshman in an undergraduate program; or
- Transferring from a two-year to a four-year post-secondary Utah institution in pursuit of a bachelor's degree.

These scholarships are intended for current or previous west side residents of Salt Lake City (incorporated). This includes zip codes 84104 and 84116 – the neighborhoods of Fairpark, Glendale, Jordan Meadows, People's Freeway, Poplar Grove, Rose Park, and Westpointe.

In addition, students are required by state law to certify that they are eligible to receive a scholarship as a U.S. citizen, or are a citizen of another country who is lawfully present in the U.S., **OR** show that they have graduated from a Utah high school by the start of the 2018-19 school year.

Please note: these scholarships are very rarely awarded the same person twice.

CONDITIONS

All scholarship recipients must agree to the following conditions:

1. Prior to receiving a scholarship, documentation must be provided showing acceptance to the post-secondary institution, or vocational or technical training program of their choice;
2. Each semester, recipients must meet with a Student Success Advocate provided by University Neighborhood Partners; and
3. Agree to participate in an exit interview at the end of the academic year.

Scholarship funds will be provided in two installments, deposited directly into the recipient's institution-specific student account at the beginning of each semester.
